

LMMS Band/Chorus/Orchestra Spring Trip 2016

Miscellaneous Information

The LMMS Music Staff strongly believes in keeping this trip cost effective for our families. We have made the decision to travel home overnight, arriving at LMMS early on Sun morning, May 15th (8:00am-ish).

ROOMS – Students room 4 to a room with 2 beds in each room and are allowed for the most part to choose their own roomies. Chaperones rooms are next door or across the hall to their group.

DOUBLERS – Students who are involved in 2 of our music programs will be asked to only perform/workshop with 1 of their groups with the priority being on the chorus performance. If they choose to workshop with their 2nd group, we are happy to accommodate that request as long as it logistically works out with the itinerary – just remember that it takes time away from your park time!

STUDENT GROUPS – This trip is designed for 1 chaperone per 8 students. When walking around the parks – a minimum of 4 students MUST be together at all times.

FOOD ALLERGIES - We will do all we can to make accommodation's for our students with food allergies, if you let us know ahead of time. Please email Mrs. Bennett.

MEDICAL FORMS – **When you are ready to turn in the yellow medical form, IT MUST BE NOTARIZED BEFORE IT CAN BE ACCEPTED. Ms. Groves and Ms. Adelman in the LMMS front office are notary's and they will be happy to provide this service for you.**

NO HEALTH INSURANCE – If your family does not have health insurance during the time of the trip, please fill out the student's name on the medical form and notate NO HEALTH INSURANCE. CCSD does offer student accident insurance from the Young Group if you are interested – but this is not mandatory. Email Theresa.bennett@cobbk12.org if you need a form.

CHAPERONES – If you are interested in chaperoning the trip, please let us know on the attached form. Once we have our student totals broken down by gender and group, we will begin the selection process. This usually begins after the first of the new year. You will be notified mid-January. **PLEASE DO NOT PAY MONEY UNTIL YOU HAVE BEEN SELECTED.** The chaperone payment is half of the student fee (\$332.50) and is due only if you are selected but must be paid by Monday, March 28, 2016. Chaperones room 2 to a room unless you want to pay the \$95 upcharge to room as a single. There will be a chaperone meeting in April for specific details of the trip and of the role of the chaperone. We need males and females!

SPECIAL CONCERNS – If your student may have any special concerns of any kind, please talk to us! Don't guess how we will respond. Let's make this a pleasant experience for all!

FAMILY PACKAGE – We are sorry to inform you that we will no longer be able to offer the Family Package to travel with our group. You are welcome to make your own travel arrangements to/from Walt Disney World. Once the itinerary is set, we will be happy to give you a copy so that you can be in the same park with us. Families are not able to go to the workshop with the students, but all are welcome at Downtown Disney for the chorus performance! We eat breakfast each day as a group either at the hotel or out at a restaurant, so don't plan on meeting up with us until we are at the parks each day!
